# **Precautions for Using the Printer**

\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ Caution

Do not disassemble the printer by yourself. Please read this manual carefully before use.



Turn off the power immediately when a malfunction occurs. When you find the printer or charger smoking or giving off a strange smell, unplug the charger at once and be careful to avoid burns.

A Warning

Don't use the printer near flammables like gas stations or fuel depots.

\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ Caution

After printing, the print head is still hot. Don't touch it to avoid burns.



Use our company's original label printing paper. Otherwise, it may lead to poor printing quality or even damage to the printer core.



If the printer is stored for a long time, be sure to take out the battery in the printer and store it separately. Otherwise, it may cause the battery to fail or even leak, thus damaging the printer.



Before replacing the battery, make sure the printer is turned off. If using a charger, make sure the power is cut off when replacing the battery.

# **Precautions for Using Batteries**



Please read this manual carefully before use.



Turn off the power immediately when a malfunction occurs. When you find the printer or charger smoking or giving off a strange smell, unplug the charger at once and be careful to avoid burns.



The battery has internal protection circuits and devices. Don't disassemble it yourself. Otherwise, it may cause short circuit or electrolyte leakage. If it gets into eyes, rinse with water and seek medical help at once.



Don't squeeze, vibrate or shake the battery. Short-circuiting it is strictly prohibited.



Don't put the battery in water to prevent internal short circuits that may cause heating, smoking, deformation, damage or even explosion.



Don't expose the battery to sunlight or places with much smoke and dust. Don't use it in high-humidity environments like bathrooms.



Please replace the battery when it fails to meet the performance requirements.



Please place the batteries in a safe place out of the reach of children to prevent danger.



Once the battery shows signs such as discoloration or deformation, please stop using it immediately.

# Precautions for using the charger:



Please read this manual and the markings on the surface of the charger carefully before use.



Please don't disassemble or modify the charger. It is strictly prohibited to use the charger when the power cord is damaged, otherwise it may lead to electric shock, fire and damage to the charger.



Please don't touch the charger with wet hands. If the charger comes into contact with water or other liquids, cut off the power immediately.



Please don't short-circuit the charger, subject it to mechanical vibration or shake it.



Please don't use the charger in places with high humidity such as bathrooms. This device is not waterproof. It is strictly prohibited to expose it to rain or moisture.



When unplugging, hold the charger. Pulling the power cord will damage the wire.



Please put the charger in a safe place out of children's reach to prevent danger.

# Instructions on the Display Screen



#### Wireless Bluetooth Mode/Setup Status Mode

Icon Explanation:



The icon blinks when there is data transmission.

# Icon Explanation

#### Printing / Paper Feeding Status

This icon indicates the printing status. It appears when the printer is printing or feeding paper.



#### Out of Paper State

This icon indicates the paper shortage. It shows up when the printer is out of paper or the paper roll isn't loaded properly, with "Paper not detected" displayed in the text area.



#### Unlocked State

This icon indicates the unlocked state. It shows when the printer's ribbon/print head lock isn't locked, with "Print head not locked" shown in the text area.



#### External Power Supply Indication

This icon indicates if the external power supply is plugged in. It shows when there's correct external power input.

#### Battery Level Indication

This icon is used to indicate the power level. When charging, the icon blinks to show the charging status.

#### T Text Messages

This area displays relevant text information.

# **Preparations Before Use**

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Note: Charge the printer fully before first use. Long charging is needed for long-stored batteries to get them in optimal condition.



The battery is installed in the printer when the product is shipped from the factory.

This chapter presents the steps for printer preparation, such as ribbon installation, battery charging and paper loading.

#### **Ribbon Installation and Precautions**



Avoid touching the ribbon with fingers or wrinkling it.



Push the ribbon/print head lock lever to the unlocked position **3** and insert the ribbon cartridge into the printer's right side.



After installing the ribbon, push the cartridge in fully and then push the lock lever forward to the locked position  $\mathfrak{B}$  to lock the cartridge and print head.

# **Battery charging**

Insert the charger plug into the power socket, and then insert the charger's DC plug into the charging interface of the printer.

DC:12V~1A(50-60Hz)





If a charger not provided or approved by our company is used, it may damage the printer.



Do not remove the battery while it is being charged.





Printing while charging will affect the battery's service life. Charging: Power indicator icon blinks. Charged: Power indicator icon shows full **CIIII** and stops blinking.

# Installation of printing paper

The printer uses roll paper (≤65mm in diameter, 20-54mm in width) as consumables.



Insert the roll of printing paper as shown in the figure.



Insert the labels into the fixing slots as illustrated in the following figure.



The surface of the label to be printed should be facing downward.



Firstly, ensure that the labels you use are the special label rolls dedicated to this model of printer provided by our company.

After inserting the labels, adjust the width of the paper compartment to match that of the labels.

Once the labels are installed properly, push the ribbon lock lever (print head lock lever) to the locked position.



Insert the front end of the label roll into the "label inlet slot" (with the label's front side down). Press the "FEED" key (while slightly pushing the label roll into the slot by hand) until the label is loaded.

# Power On

Press and hold the power button of the printer for 2 seconds continuously to turn on the printer.

#### **Power Off**

While the printer is in the powered-on state, press and hold the power button for 2 seconds continuously to turn off the printer.

#### **Paper Feeding**

Press the FEED key: be fed through.



## Auto Power-off

The printer will turn off automatically after remaining in the standby state for a specific period of time.



## Access the design interface: After powering on.

# **Routine Printer Maintenance**

1. Clean the printer exterior and paper tray: Gently wipe the printer surface and paper tray interior with a wrung damp cloth. Ensure it's fully wrung.

2、Clean the printer mechanism: Clean it regularly, especially when print quality drops. The cleaning method is as follows:



- 3. If water gets inside the printer, turn it off at once, remove the battery and let it dry naturally.
- 4、 If not using the printer for a long time, take out the battery and store it separately.

Use and storage of print consumables

A. Keep the product at normal room temperature before it is opened.B. When pasting consumables, please clean the surface to be pasted.

# Fault Diagnosis

Fault Phenomenon	Cause of the Fault	Resolutions
The printer prints blurrily.	The printer's movement has been contaminated by dirt due to long - term lack of cleaning.	It is necessary to clean the printer's movement.

The printer beeps three times with short "dingdingding" sounds.	The print head is not locked during printing.	Lock the print head.
The printed labels have become blurry within a few months or even weeks.	The quality of consumables is poor.	Please choose our company's high-quality labels and ribbons.
The printer shuts down automatically.	The printer shuts down automatically.	Please charge it immediately.

#### **Battery Recycling**

#### Attention - Printer Installation and Handling

- This product uses rechargeable lithium batteries. For environmental protection, don't discard used batteries randomly.
- Install the label paper roll in the correct way and pass it through the paper guide slot.
- Please make sure that the print head is in the locked state before paper feeding and printing.
- The print head is a precision and fragile component. Please avoid touching it directly with hands or hard objects.
- Please use the dedicated power adapter.

#### **Precautions for the Print Head**

Always turn off the printer's power supply before cleaning.

Since the temperature of the print head can become very high during printing, if you want to clean the print head, please turn off the printer's power supply for 2 to 3 minutes first, and then start the cleaning operation.

When cleaning the print head, be careful not to touch the heating part of the print head - the print head is extremely vulnerable to damage from factors such as static electricity. Note that the print head must not be scratched or damaged in any way.

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
